ENGLISH

As part of our English program, students will develop their knowledge of letter-sound relationships, learn to identify high frequency words and practise letter formation skills during handwriting.

Our daily routines include the use of Big Books and quality literature, explicit teaching of phonemic awareness and participation in group learning activities.

Guided reading groups and the home reading program will begin in week five.

SPECIALIST PROGRAMS

Music:

In music, kindergarten will perform a repertoire of simple songs and rhymes. They will learn the concept of beat.

French:

Students will be introduced to greetings, counting numbers 1 to 20, and will learn the sound of the alphabets in French.

Drama:

In drama, students will be responding and making drama through games and storytelling.

INQUIRY

Our unit of inquiry this term is called 'We are a Family'. We will be exploring personal characteristics. Part of our unit will be devoted to expressing likes and dislikes and exploring what makes us unique.

In History, we will construct a simple family tree and explain how family members are related. We will be comparing different family structures.

In Science, students will focus on observing, asking questions about and describing changes in objects and events.

MATHEMATICS

The mathematics focus in the early stages of the term is on counting, number identification and representation.

Students will use concrete materials and pictorial representations and practise writing numerals. They will learn through a variety of teaching methods including open ended inquiries, real life tasks and games.

This term, we will also be focusing on measurement, patterns, addition, groups and collections and two dimensional shapes.
