ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Majura Swimming Carnival and Water Activities Day will consist of swimming races of 50m and 100m for students who are **competent** at swimming these distances. To enter into the 100m races your child must be competent at making the distance within 2½ minutes.

Students who are in year 2 but are only turning 7 in 2018 are still able to attend the swimming carnival if they choose to do so, they may also choose to stay at school and participate in the junior school Water Fun day. Those turning 7 are welcome to compete in the swimming races, however, if placed, will not be able to attend North Gungahlin Swimming carnival due to an age restriction of 8 and over.

Once the races are completed, we will be running structured water-based rotations for all students to participate. **Please complete the swimming ability note to indicate your child's abilities.** The carnival is a great day for all students to be a part of their house group by cheering and supporting their peers. We encourage all students to dress in their house colours:

Bunduluk (Red)
Galu (Blue)
Karrugang (White)
Mulleun (Yellow).

If your child would like to enter into the swimming races the entry form must be completed, signed by a parent/guardian and returned **before Friday 7 December 2018**. No entries will be accepted after this date or on the day of the carnival as all the heats and lanes are organised prior to the carnival. If your child is in a swimming club and would like to be considered for the 200IM or 200m Freestyle, please come and see Louise Johnston.

If you are able to assist on the day, please fill in the parent help form and return it to the front office. You will be contacted via email with more information. Parent help is vital in making the day run smoothly.
