TERM 2, 2026 SGP

Welcome back SGP students and families. Term 2 has lots of upcoming events, including several public holidays and special occasions for us to learn about and observe, like Anzac Day, Reconciliation Week and Mother's Day. We will also be participating in different ways in the Majura cross country and athletics carnival days. Term 2 also brings changes in weather – while we make our rooms as comfortable in temperature as possible, layers of clothes can also be helpful. Please make sure jumpers and jackets are labelled to avoid confusion.

ENGLISH

Students participate in literacy every morning. These sessions include reading, comprehension, fine motor skill development and handwriting, phonics, and writing. The learning activities are individualised to meet each student's needs.

Reading- We have a variety of reading activities every day – individual and shared opportunities across both SGP rooms. Students are also given opportunity to engage in comprehension activities to develop their vocabulary and connections to a range of texts.

Writing- Students practise fine motor development, handwriting, sentence structure and text structure. They have opportunities to write their own texts and this term we will focus on writing **recounts**.

Phonics and spelling- Students are continuing to build their phonics and spelling skills and knowledge, working at their own individual progressions. These align with the Majura scope and sequence and Strong Foundations as part of everyday literacy learning activities.

MATHEMATICS

Students continue to work towards their individual numeracy goals, this term focussing particularly on building confidence and fluency, as well as exploring different ways that numeracy is used in daily life.

We will also be learning about two- and three-dimensional shapes by exploring, manipulating, and comparing shapes of different sizes. We explore how shapes and objects can be moved within a space, and will begin to use fundamental positional language to describe placement and movement.

INVESTIGATIONS

We are continuing to explore the different forces that impact the world around us, from basic cause and effect through to the influence of 'invisible' forces including friction and gravity. We will experiment with how we can use these forces in different ways with different materials and objects.

We will also explore our world – local, national and international. We will look at how mapping works in different ways to show locations of places. We will learn about the different environments where living things are on Earth, and how we can care for places into the future.

SPECIALIST PROGRAMS AND CLASS ACTIVITIES

Sustainability with Mel – Students will continue to experience sustainability sessions this term every Tuesday afternoon. During this time, they will take part in key environmental events on the national and international calendar including 'World Bee Day', World Environment Day' and 'World Oceans Day'. Students will take part in gardening activities to overhaul and maintain the external garden beds and cooking experiences to learn about sustainable cooking practices.

Arts with Caitlin – This term, the small group program will be encouraged to participate in creative experiences with Caitlin. Students will be exposed to a variety of hands-on and sensory arts-based activities designed to encourage students to develop artistic expression and using texture in their artworks.

Indonesian with Mr Chad – Students will have the opportunity to learn about our northern neighbour, Indonesia. They will learn some basic greetings, numbers, colours and facts about animals and the environment.

















Health & PE – There will be daily opportunities for students to participate in movement activities to support continued development of fundamental movement skills and movement sequence planning (where do I want to move to and how can I move my body safely to get there?).

Wednesday afternoon buddies - Year-level peers will come to the SGP rooms to participate in cooperative learning games and activities. Junior and senior buddies will alternate weeks, depending on assembly times.










Friday afternoon library – Every Friday SGP has class library time. If you would like your child to borrow for home, please make sure that you send in a named library bag to keep books safe. Home borrowing can recur each time books are returned.







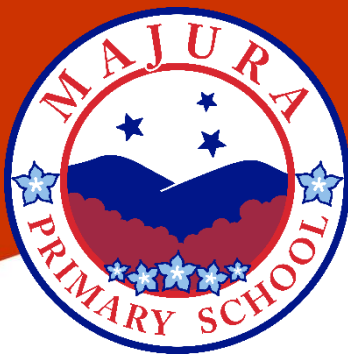
