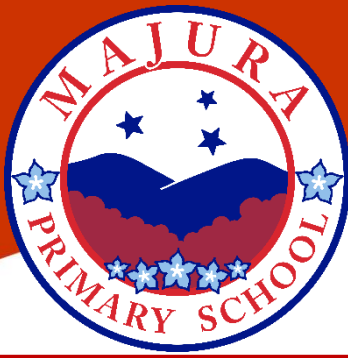

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MATHEMATICS

This term, there will continue to be a strong focus on number. Students will work with all four operations involving decimals and apply their numerical understanding across different mathematical strands and problem-solving scenarios. Students will order, add, and subtract common fractions, as well as tackle problems that require finding a fraction, decimal, or percentage of a given amount.

Mathematical modelling will be used to address financial situations, with a particular focus on developing reasoning skills.

HEALTH & PE

This term, students will focus on building communication skills, using protective behaviours, and applying help-seeking strategies to stay safe both online and offline. They will learn how to analyse health information to make informed decisions that support their own and others' health, safety, relationships, and wellbeing. Activities will include role-plays, discussions, and group tasks.

SCIENCE AND HASS

In our HASS unit this term, students will deepen their understanding of economics and the decision-making processes involved in business. To prepare for Market Day, they will explore aspects of running a small business and develop a comprehensive business plan for their own stall. They will work collaboratively with their 'stall' group, discussing ideas, creating resources and promoting their stall throughout the school, during the term.

SPECIALIST PROGRAMS

PE – Year 6 students will apply rugby skills and tactical thinking through modified games and team challenges. Students will develop their kicking techniques, decision making and support play while demonstrating leadership, collaboration and fair play. These experiences will encourage students to think strategically and apply their skills confidently in game situations.

Indonesian - This semester, students will revise and extend their Bahasa Indonesia vocabulary including greetings, feelings, days, months, colours and numbers. They will develop their use of varied vocabulary and sentence structures to create spoken and written texts, while continuing to refine pronunciation and intonation. Students will explore language related to classroom objects, teacher instructions and school features. They will learn about traditional Indonesian markets, including descriptive language for fruit, vegetables and other local foods. A range of texts and digital resources will be used to support their learning, while students continue to develop their understanding and appreciation of Indonesian culture, traditions and daily life.

Media art - In specialist art lessons this term, students in year six will be participating in Media arts lessons. Students will undertake a variety of Media art projects and produce pieces that incorporate different styles and techniques based upon their own ideas, taking inspiration from the work of known artists. Students will produce digital media art pieces using programs such as Kleki and Canva.
