ENGLISH

The English activities covered this term will include:

- spelling, punctuation and vocabulary development through a variety of writing tasks and the Soundwaves spelling program

- speaking and listening skills including role play through Media Arts

MATHEMATICS

Mathematics topics this term will include:

- 2D shapes and 3D objects
- Chance and probability
- Four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) and times tables

HEALTH & PE

SPECIALISTS

Music: Students will continue to explore the use of rhythmic, pitch and form symbols in the two and three part harmonies that they perform.

Performing Arts: This term students will be participating in Media Arts lessons. They will work collaboratively to develop and use media languages and technologies to construct representations in arts works for specific purposes.

French: Students will become familiar with French school routines and cultural practices around French National Day. They will steadily engage in more explicit language functions when utilizing the adjective and stem words. Themes such as after school life, camp and recreational activities form the learning context, where students can recall, practice and experiment with language patterns and functions.

HASS and SCIENCE

HASS – Business and Economics: Students will have the opportunity to work with a small group to create a small business that includes a business plan, marketing, and budgeting.

Science – What's the Matter: Students will classify substances according to observable properties and behaviours. They will follow instructions to pose questions for investigations and predict the effect of changing variables when planning an investigation.
