WELCOME TO TERM 4

Welcome to term 4. It's been a great year so far and we are looking forward to our final term together as year 3! With the weather warming up, please remind your child to pack a labelled hat and drink bottle to bring to school each day.

ENGLISH

Students will be reading fiction and non-fiction texts and will focus on summarising, note taking and rewording information when writing. They will be continuing the Soundwaves program, focusing on using knowledge of phonemic awareness and unusual spelling patterns to spell words with greater accuracy. Students will be writing historical recounts which is linked with our HASS unit. They will also be continuing to develop the editing process within narrative writing. During writing, students will build knowledge of grammar, vocabulary, and punctuation, especially looking at sentence structure and paragraphing.

HASS & TECHNOLOGY

In HASS students continue to learn about significant people and events in our country's history. We will specifically link our learning to Australia's First Nations People and their connection to country through the stories 'Freedom Day' and 'Say Yes'.

Students will also be learning about different celebrations that take place around the world during their rotations, which are run by the year 3 teachers.

In technology, students will be planning a sequence of steps to solve technological problems. Specifically, using coding and Spheros.

MATHEMATICS

The topics that the students will be focusing on this term will include:

Addition, subtraction & multiplication: Recalls facts for single digit numbers. Word problems will be embedded across these above concepts.

Fractions: Model and represent unit fractions

Chance: Conduct chance experiments and list possible

outcomes

Mapping: Matches positions on maps with given information.

Time: Students tell time to the nearest minute.

SPECIALIST PROGRAMS

Music:

Students will continue to demonstrate their aural skills and reading with accurate pitch, rhythm, and will perform two-part harmony.

Visual Arts:

This term in specialists Arts lessons, students will be participating in Visual Arts Lessons. They will explore lines, shapes, colours, textures, and form to produce artworks of their own using a variety of materials such as paper, clay, and paint.

HEALTH & PE
