Dear Parents and Carers,

Majura Primary School will be celebrating Harmony Day on Thursday, 21 March. Harmony Day is celebrated as part of Harmony Week which is a time to celebrate Australian multiculturalism and the diversity that enriches our nation.

Harmony Day celebrates inclusiveness, respect and belonging for all Australians, regardless of cultural or linguistic background. These ideals closely mirror the values we hold in the Majura community.

On Harmony Day at Majura, children, staff (and parents and carers!) will be encouraged to wear their 'National Dress' or clothing which represents their country or culture. There is also the option to wear the colour 'orange' for harmony.

There will be the opportunity for children to perform a dance from their country, sing a song, share a story etc. They can choose to perform at a special Harmony Day assembly or to share information about their country or culture with their class.

Children are encouraged to bring in food from their country (allergy friendly) and to talk about it with their class. Please note that we won't be sharing food with others on this day.

Preschool families – children will engage in Harmony Day activities throughout the week.

If you would like to get involved with your child/ren's class on Harmony Day (sharing a story, information about your country or culture etc), please let your class teacher know directly. Class teachers will be organising a Harmony Day activity for their class.
