#### WELCOME TO TERM 4

#### ENGLISH

In English, students will be examining poetry and building on their understanding of how language features, images and vocabulary are used by authors. They will continue to practise editing skills to check for correct spelling, grammar and vocabulary choices. Students will continue to refine public speaking skills by presenting research projects to the class and will be provided with opportunities to contribute to class and group discussions. Digital literacy remains a focus with emphasis on researching, note taking, paraphrasing, touch typing and being a safe online citizen.

#### HEALTH & PE

In PE lessons students will build their knowledge in athletics skills and team building games.

During Health lessons, students will continue learning about nutrition and making safe and informed decisions. They will continue to investigate identity, emotional influences, and cyber safety.

#### MATHEMATICS

The topics covered in Mathematics this term are:

- Describing probability using simple fractions, decimals, and percentages
- Converting fractions, decimals, and percentages
- Calculating common percentage discounts on sale items
- Labelling a Cartesian Plane and locating and plotting ordered pairs
- Describing combinations of transformation
- Angles - using properties of angles to solve problems.
- Mass, capacity, volume

#### SPECIALIST PROGRAMS

##### Music:

Students will continue to explore the use of rhythmic, pitch, form and harmonic symbols in the music they perform and create.
