# Permission for Web Based Service Provider- Seesaw

#### Dear Parents & Carers

I am happy to inform you that Majura Primary will be continuing to use Seesaw (<u>http://seesaw.me</u>), a secure online journal where students can document and reflect on what they are learning in class. As your child's work will be documented electronically throughout the year, Seesaw will replace a hard copy portfolio that has been used in previous years.

Each week, your child or child's teacher, will be able to add the things classes are working on (including photos, videos, worksheets, drawings and voice recordings) to their Seesaw journal, and teachers will share them privately with you and other family members to view throughout the school year. Please note, email will continue to be the primary method of parent-teacher communication therefore if you wish to communicate with your child's teacher, please email them directly.

For your child to use Seesaw, the app needs your child's name so their work can be associated with their account. Seesaw only uses this information to provide this service and doesn't advertise in Seesaw, create profiles of students, or share or sell your child's personal information or journal content. I hope your child will enjoy using Seesaw to document and share their learning this year. As our school wishes to register with a web-based service provider that requires some personal information about students, I am obliged under the Information Privacy Act 2014 to advise you of the reasons for collecting the information, what will be done with it, the consequence of not collecting it and who else may have access to it. Please complete and sign below and return this permission slip at your earliest convenience. Once this permission form has been returned, you will receive an invitation to join your child's Seesaw account.

The information you provide on the form below will give consent (or not) for your child to access the following third-party website. Please note that Seesaw is a user pays service, and therefore you will only be able to have access once the school has received your payment. For 2024, Seesaw costs were included in the stationery pack, so if you have already paid for this, you will have automatic access to Seesaw. If you have not yet paid for a bookpack and would like your child to be able to share their work with you via Seesaw, you will need to pay the school directly.
