In the last two weeks we have continued to get to know each other, and to learn about how our preschool day runs. I am mindful that this is a very big transition for all of my little Blueberries, and what I most want them to learn is that preschool is a happy and safe place to be.

We have been beginning our day with a story told with puppets and soft toys, with our favourites so far being *The Three Little Pigs* and *The Wide Mouthed Frog*.
