Our goal for the Yr 6 cohort is that all profits go towards reducing the costs for end of year events for our Yr 6 students including:

- Yr 6 Dinner and Disco

As these end of year events can be expensive, we are all working hard to make the most out of Market Day to reduce costs for all the students and families later this year.
