## Wakakirri 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are on the final run to Wakakirri! There are a few reminders about the day.

### Key information

**Date:** August 3 2022 – leaving Majura Primary at approx. 1.45pm

**Venue:** Canberra Theatre

**Transport:** Students will be taken by bus from Majura Primary School to the Canberra Theatre at approx. 1.45pm. Students will then be supervised at the theatre by Majura Primary School staff until the end of the show until approximately 8.45pm. ***There is no need to collect your child at the end of the school day, they will remain supervised at the theatre. You will need to collect your child from the stage door at the conclusion of the evening.***

**Food:** We will be providing pizza for dinner. Students are asked to bring all other food for the day, please avoid lunch orders as this will be complicated with students being out of class. Students will need a water bottle and “costume friendly” finger food for the afternoon and evening.

### Costumes/Hair/Make up

**Beach kids:** Students are asked to bring their summer clothes in asap. Please ensure all items are labelled and in a labelled bag.

(Bright and colourful, anything you would normally wear in summer. We do ask for no swimwear or midriff showing and if wearing skirts or dresses please wear bike shorts underneath)

**Hair/Make Up:** During the morning and afternoon at the Canberra Theatre, staff will be assisting students to apply makeup and style their hair. Due to hygiene reasons we are unable to provide hair and make up for the students so please pack the following:

- Comb/brush
- Bobby pins (for fish and beach kids)
- Bun pins (for smog)
- Hair ties
- Hair spray
- Foundation
- Powder (optional)
- Blush
- Mascara
- Red lipstick
- Make up sponges

The purpose of makeup is to simply give your child expression and be seen clearly from the audience while on stage. It is not designed to make them look older and we have selected very minimal stage make up to help ensure students feel comfortable.
