Voluntary Contributions and Subject Contributions 2024

Voluntary contributions are funds provided by the parent/carer community to the school. These contributions provide opportunities to enhance the educational experiences for all our students beyond what is possible with Government funding. It was great to see Majura's voluntary contributions increase 2022 and remain steady in 2023. The School Board is hoping to increase this funding support towards a goal of 35% in 2024.

Parents/carers can select to contribute in one of the following ways:

(option A) Voluntary contribution

(option B) Contribution to the Library Trust Fund

(option C) 50% to Voluntary contribution and 50% to Library Trust Fund

All contributions to the Library Trust Fund are *tax deductible*; these funds can only be spent on library purchases. In 2023 we purchased new library shelving for the growing supply of library books, comfortable cushions and ottomans and a colourful alphabet rug for students to enjoy reading in a relaxed environment.

Voluntary contributions are not tax deductible and can be used for a range of educational resources and programs which so many Majura students use and/or participate in. Some of these include:

- Musical instruments
- Sporting equipment
- Fine and gross motor equipment
- Enhancement of outdoor play and wellbeing spaces
- Resources specific to specific programs, eg; Music and Performing Arts

The Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden program is offered to years 3-5. The program is designed to develop a lifelong appreciation of fresh, seasonal and delicious food. We have employed professional staff within the horticultural and hospitality industry to support the 10 kitchen garden fundamentals. The subject contributions will assist the garden program through purchase of tools, seeds and seedlings, chicken care and replacement of new fruiting plants. In the kitchen program the contributions go towards kitchen staples that are not grown in the garden to ensure a holistic kitchen garden experience.
