MATHEMATICS

This term, there will continue to be a strong focus on number. Students will use all four operations with decimals and will apply their knowledge of number in mathematical strands and problem solving.

Students will explore probabilities using common fractions, decimals and percentages and record outcomes from trials of chance experiments.

Collecting and representing data will tie in with HASS where students will investigate where families come from and use this information to create graphs for different data sets.

HEALTH & PE

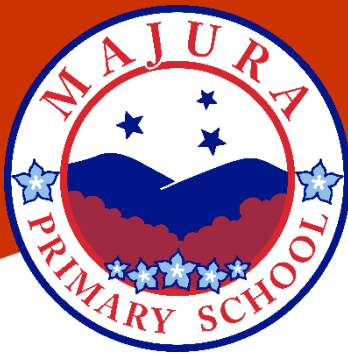
This term in health, students will be developing strategies to manage emotions, developmental changes and transitions.

Students will be exploring stereotypes and other elements that impact relational dynamics to develop social skills such as conflict resolution, empathy and positive communication.

SCIENCE AND HASS

Our HASS unit 'Take a Walk on this Land we call Australia' takes students through an inquiry process to describe the impact of Federation on Australia, including the significant events and individuals involved. Students will develop knowledge through looking at life in 20th-century Australia and the impact on women, children and First Nation Australians. This will lead into citizenship of migrants and their stories. Students will visit Parliament House to learn about the two houses and parliamentary processes.

In science, students will explore the relationship between the sun and planets and explain how the relative positions of Earth and the sun relate to observed phenomena on Earth. Students will experience a planetarium that will be set up at school.

SPECIALIST PROGRAMS

PE – This term, year 6 students will apply specialised movement skills to correctly perform progressed athletics techniques: shot put, discus, and strategic long jumping. They will focus on race pacing, safe landing, and performance analysis while taking leadership roles. Students will act as officials, coaches, and team captains to ensure fair play, inclusion, and ethical competition.

Indonesian - In Indonesian, students will continue to develop their basic conversational skills, cultural awareness and appreciation for our northern neighbour. They will increase their written and spoken vocabulary to sequence a conversation with others, based on modelled conversations. Students will use spoken Indonesian to identify their feelings, likes and dislikes for a variety of topics. Students will continue to build their understanding of classroom instructions and knowledge of school objects in Indonesian. Students will make connections with Indonesian culture, identifying similarities and differences between our two nations. Various online platforms and tools will be utilised to support and strengthen student knowledge, understanding and skill in written and spoken Indonesian.

Visual art - This semester students in year 6 will continue participating in visual arts lessons. With a partner, students will create and produce a steampunk style insect sculpture. Students will continue to explore the use of the elements line, colour, colour and shape, within artworks.
